Robert's book tends to fall apart a bit toward the end, with meanderings off into discussions of the state of religious life in America in the 21st century, and throughout there is a certain narrative awkwardness. Best in describing Chittister's earlier life and the pre-Vatican II Catholic world she was a part of, good in dealing with the post-Vatican II convulsions in the church, weakest at dealing with the more recent chapters of this remarkable woman's life.
